REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING

April 12, 2011

The regular meeting was opened for business by Mayor Holleman at 5:30 p.m.

The invocation was given by Mayor Holleman. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Robinette and seconded by Commissioner Poole to add item 5a to the agenda for the contract for Servepro. The motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner Robinette and seconded by Commissioner Poole to adopt the agenda as presented. The motion was passed unanimously.

Town Manager, David Odom gave a brief report on the status of the damages to town hall. The damages are extensive and will require most all of the interior of all of town hall to be removed, cleaned and replaced. Our insurance carrier will cover most of the damages except for the cost of the mold removal. It is estimated to take 8 weeks or more to be back operational. All local contractors will be used for the repairs.

A motion was made by Commissioner Poole and seconded by Commissioner Robinette to approve the signing by David Odom of the contract for Servepro to clean and remove the interior contents of town hall. Insurance will cover all except \$22,000 of the expense which is for the mold removal. The motion was passed unanimously.

Action for item #6 for the budget amendments was tabled until May until for information is available due to the damages inside town hall.

Action for item #7 for the budget amendments was tabled until May until for information is available due to the damages inside town hall.

By unanimous consent, town manager David Odom was given permission to use vinyl shakes on the roof like was used on the new concession stand at town ballpark.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lerner and seconded by Commissioner Poole to grant permission to the police department to apply for 3 grants in order to receive funding for in-car cameras, bullet-proof vests and a traffic officer for 3 years. Included in the motion is direction for Police Chief Tony Jones to purchase a new radio. The motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Commissioner and seconded by Commissioner Lerner to adopt a Resolution opposing the consolidation of the mail service centers and moving jobs to Greensboro. The motion was passed unanimously. See attachment A, which is hereby incorporated and made a part of these minutes.
